All his lions were raised in his home since birth they have come to see him and their trainers as part of the pride. With mutual love and respect, they have formed a very special bond. With their affection training methods and positive reinforcement, they are able to expand the relationship between man and animal and maintain the highest safety standards, animal care and enrichment in the industry. All of their lions are permitted with USDA, American Humane and all other local,

state, federal and international animal agencies.

## SHOW CONTENT

- Display and daily presentations
- Interaction between man and Lion and the personal relationship the trainers have with each lion.
- Educational information on Lions in the wild and in captivity, their care and the trainers' dedication and responsibility to them.
- Showcases the Lions natural beauty, grace and agility through their "Affection Training" methods.
- Questions and answers with the audience.

SHOW LENGTH: 3: 30 minute shows a day

## SHOW SUPPLIES:

- ▶ 1 male (or Lufuno) and 5 females ▶ Steel arena - 14' high & 32' in diameter with a 4' perimeter
- ▶ safety fencing around the exhibition Staff/trainers All necessary equipment

# WALKING WITH LIONS

## 'BUYER SUPPLIES:

- (1) 100 amp. 220 volt service within 50' of site
- On-site water hookup
- On-site parking & full hookup for 21 ft. house trailer (included in the exhibition area)
- Admission and parking passes
- Off-site parking for 1 pick-up truck
- Bleachers (optional but preferred)
- Dumpster & sewage at site emptied daily
- Local Accommodations (one room within 8 miles) for fair dates & 1 day before & after
- Reimbursement of any additional local permits required at the venue
- Labor to help set up and tear down
- Wood shavings, if performing "open-air". If performing on pavement, concrete, or other hard surfaces fair must provide a floor base consisting of 3-4" of dirt in the 32' diameter performance area and 1 to 2" of wood shavings or sawdust (approximately a 15 yard truck load or 60 bags) to cover dirt base.

**AREA NEEDED:** Minimum area needed (not including audience seating) is 60 x 80 (alternate configurations for set up can be discussed with Trainers). Please note that we must have enough space to maneuver the trailer and equipment in and out of the site.

**SET-UP & TEAR-DOWN:** 6-8 hours set-up & tear-down

**DAILY MILEAGE TRAVELED:** 500 miles (8-10 hours)

**PUBLICITY AND VIDEO AVAILABLE:** Yes

**COST:** \$ 2,500.00 Per day (depending on route & length)
