Brian McMillan has created a new show that combines education and entertainment into a dynamic adventure into the wilds of India. Their show will excite and entertain your audience and at the same time foster a desire to preserve and learn about the endangered species, *Panthera Tigris*, THE TIGER and the planet around them



The trainers will demonstrate our affection training methods while showing the audience what these beautiful creatures are capable of when put in a caring and mutually respectful environment. Experienced and knowledgeable trainers will discuss why we are losing these beautiful creatures in the wild.

All of these animals have been bottle-raised, since they were small cubs, with the trainers who are with them today and everyday. The importance of a strong bond and mutual respect is necessary when dealing with animals of this caliber. Any member of the audience easily sees this bond and respect from the interaction between the trainers and the Tigers.

These Tigers are movie stars and you have seen them in many films, commercials, television shows, and magazine advertisements. From movies such as **Evan Almighty** and **Jungle Book** to television shows like **CSI NY** and **Monk**. From **American Express** and **Esso/Exxon** commercials to **Vogue** and **Vanity Fair** print ads, these animals capture the hearts and minds of everyone who sees them

SHOW CONTENT:

- Display and daily presentations
- Interaction between the trainer & a wide variety of big cats & the personal relationship the trainers have with each animal.
- Educational information on Tigers in the wild & in captivity, their care & the trainers' dedication & responsibility to them.
- See the natural beauty, grace & agility of the Tigers while working in concert with one of our trainers.
- Demonstrations of how they are affectionately trained with positive reinforcement to "act" in films & television.
- Questions & answers with the audience before & after each show.

SHOW LENGTH:

- 3: 30 minute shows a day; Animals on exhibit throughout the day & participating in playtime in their enclosure or arena, at the discretion of the trainer on hand.

SHOW SUPPLIES:

- Steel arena & all necessary equipment
- 2-3 staff/trainers
- 3 Bengal Tigers

BUYER SUPPLIES:

- (1) 100 amp. 220 volt service within 50' of site, (4) 110 volt, 3 amp breakers
- On-site water hookup & dumpster & sewage at site emptied daily
- On-site parking for truck and trailer with access for driving the truck and trailer out of the venue at the beginning and end of each day.
- Admission & parking passes
- 2 bags of ice a day
- Bleachers (optional but preferred)
- Local Accommodations (one room within 8 miles) for fair dates & a day before & after the fair

BUYER SUPPLIES (cont):

- Labor (2) to help set up and tear down
- To acquire & pay in advance for any necessary state or local permits as required by law for the performance of the show at the venue.
- Wood shavings, if performing "open-air". If performing on pavement or concrete we will need a clean dirt floor base in addition to wood shavings.

AREA NEEDED: Minimum area need is 35 x 60 ft (alternate configurations for set up can be discussed with Trainers). Please note that we must have enough space to maneuver the truck and trailer in & out of the site at the beginning and end of each day of the fair.

SET-UP & TEAR-DOWN: 8 hours set-up & tear-down 6 hours with buyer providing 2 people to help

DAILY MILEAGE TRAVELED: 500 miles (8 hours)

COST: \$ 2500.00/Day with a minimum of 4 days - depending on route & length.

This is the minimum size set up.

However, please note that we must have enough space to maneuver the truck and trailer to enter and exit each day from the site.
